The Open Book Collective hosts a number resources beyond Copim Compass, and rather duplicate content, we will provide links to these.

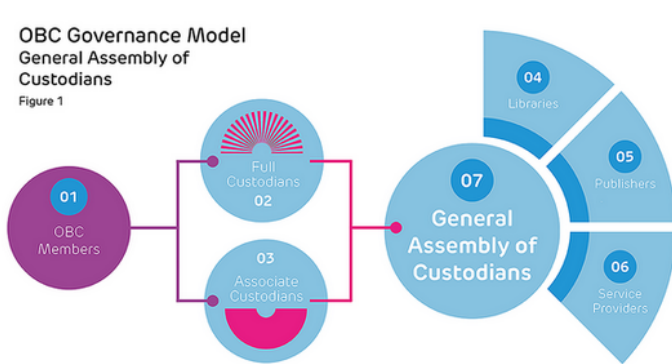

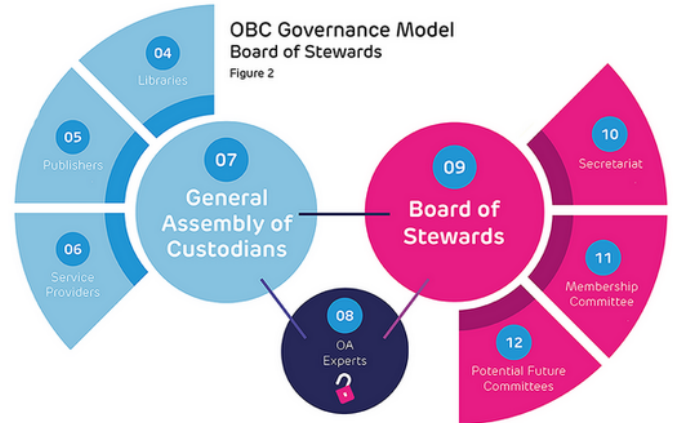
Executive summary
