About

Toth is a non-profit, open metadata management and dissemination platform providing open solutions for small- and medium-sized book publishers to disseminate OA content openly, globally and effectively, and through both traditional supply chains and emerging routes.

Toth enables book publishers to implement good metadata practice pertaining to Open Science and Scholarship, including the provision of [Persistent Identifiers](#) (PIDs) – such as [DOIs](#) for works, [ORCIDs](#) for contributors, and [ROR](#) for institutions – as well as integrating controlled vocabularies (such as BISAC and Thema) for subject classification, and the provision of a full [Crossmark](#) integration within Toth's data model.

At Toth, we firmly believe in providing publishers with the freedom to choose their own path. Our commitment to openness ensures that publishers are not locked into any specific platform or service. Toth's open architecture and APIs empower publishers to integrate seamlessly with other platforms and workflows, allowing for greater flexibility and adaptability. Toth enables publishers to retain full control over their data and operations. With Toth, you're not just accessing a platform – you're joining a community-driven ecosystem built on the principles of openness, collaboration, and innovation.

Software and services

Toth's software is open source, and in line with open data principles, the multiple output formats and specifications (e.g. ONIX, MARC, KBART, Crossref XML, json) for more than a dozen platforms are all released under a CC0 dedication.

More specifically, Toth offers:

- [Metadata management](#) for books and chapters (both OA and non-OA titles).
- Automated [distribution](#) to various platforms.
- [Archiving](#) and preservation of scholarly works.
- Automated [DOI registration](#) and management via Toth Crossref Sponsorship.
- Open APIs for seamless integration with other platforms.
- [Toth Hosting](#), including hosting of a publisher's publications, website and catalogue hosting, and provision of privacy-respecting usage statistics.
